It is recommended to take 4 – 7 courses.</p> <p><i>*Please note: Exchange students may not be permitted to attend courses offered within the degree program Global Business Management (GBM), as the number of participants is strictly limited for these courses.</i></p>

Why are you a suitable candidate for the WeltWeit scholarship? Scholarships	
WeltWeit Study Scholarship	<p>The WeltWeit Study Scholarship partially finances the first exchange semester for <u>one</u> outstanding applicant within the exchange program.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Amount: 2,400 € - Application: All applicants for the exchange program automatically apply for the scholarship, no further documents are required.
Scholarship for Dedicated WeltWeit Students	<p>The Scholarship for Dedicated WeltWeit Students partially finances the second exchange semester for <u>one</u> particularly dedicated participant of the WeltWeit program.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Amount: 2,400 €

- Application: within the first exchange semester, 1,5 months after arrival

Others	
Visa	Visa regulations depend on the student's nationality, and visa procedures vary according to the country of the home university.
Health insurance	Health insurance is mandatory in Germany and required for visa processes as well as for enrollment at the university. Taking out <u>public</u> German health insurance is strongly recommended. (Costs: approx. 91 € per month)
Tuition fee / semester fee	There is no tuition fee. However, all exchange students must pay the semester fee of 114.85 €. It consists of the semester ticket (free public transport within Augsburg) and the Studentenwerk fee (student services organization that runs the dormitories, the Mensa and the cafeterias on campus).
Accommodation	All WeltWeit exchange students are guaranteed a single apartment in one of the Studentenwerk's dormitories close to campus or close to the inner city. Further information: http://www.aaa.uni-augsburg.de/en/incoming/weltweit/general/dorm/
Tutor program (buddy program)	One month before arrival, all WeltWeit students will be paired with a personal tutor - a student from the University of Augsburg who volunteers to help them with administrative steps and course registration, and assist them in becoming familiar with the university and day-to-day life in Germany. The tutor program is organized by the International Office in cooperation with the student organization ESN Augsburg.
